Liberty Bancorp, Inc. Declares Cash Dividend

Liberty, Missouri ([Sept. 24, 2007](#)) - Liberty Bancorp, Inc. (NASDAQ: LBCP) On [Aug. 15, 2007](#), the Board of Directors of Liberty Bancorp, Inc. declared a quarterly cash dividend on the Company's outstanding common stock. The cash dividend of \$.025 per share will be payable on [Sept. 24, 2007](#) to the stockholders of record at the close of business on [Sept. 7, 2007](#).

Brent M. Giles, President and Chief Executive Officer, stated that the Board of Directors determined that the payment of a dividend was appropriate in consideration of the Company's capital position. He noted that future dividends would depend upon the Company's financial condition, earnings, equity structure, capital needs and regulatory requirements, and economic conditions.
